Famed Rock City's Enchanted Garden of Lights On Lookout Mountain Highlight of Nation's Holiday Celebrations

LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN, GA -- It's beginning to look a lot like Christmas, as Rock City Gardens prepares for its 14th Annual "Enchanted Garden of Lights." This award-winning, light extravaganza will feature more than 25 holiday scenes that transform the gardens' natural daytime splendor into a nocturnal fantasyland.

From November 21st through January 3rd, visitors "See Rock City" in a whole new light, as 500,000 starbright lights illuminate age-old rock formations along the Enchanted Trail. The lighting spectacular ranges from glittering snowflakes to a life-sized lighted gingerbread house. The Enchanted Garden of Lights is open nightly from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m., except for Christmas Eve night.

A special treat is the nightly concert series. Guests can enjoy hot cocoa and listen to holiday music performed in Rock City's Pavilion. See www.seerockcity.com for a complete listing.

"The Enchanted Garden of Lights has enormous appeal," said Bill Chapin, president of Rock City. "We expect more than 50,000 visitors this year as it grows as a family holiday tradition."

Now in its 76th season of operation, Rock City Gardens is one of the south's oldest and most popular natural attractions and is listed as a top 5 American roadside attraction. Located atop Lookout Mountain, approximately six miles from downtown Chattanooga, Tennessee, Rock City is a marvel of nature featuring massive ancient rock formations, gardens with more than 400 different native plant species, and panoramic views 1700 feet above sea level.

Rock City Gardens' Enchanted Garden of Lights is a recipient of the Southeast Tourism Society's coveted "Shining Example Award" and is one of their "Top 20 Events." It is a production of Select Productions International, whose earlier projects have ranged from Super Bowl revues to Disneyland galas.

Rock City Gardens is open daily from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. through January 5, 2008, except Christmas Day and reopens as Rock City's Enchanted Garden of Lights at 6:00 p.m. Admission is \$15.95 for adults, \$8.95 for children ages 3-12, and free for children aged 2 and under.
