ROCK CITY'S ENCHANTED MAiZE: Get Lost

With ten acres of corn planted and their new mind-boggling design now created, Rock City Gardens is bringing the "maze craze" back for its 7th season to North Georgia and the Tennessee Valley.

The popular Chattanooga area labyrinth, that drew thousands of visitors last fall, will once again get curious maze-goers lost when it opens to the public on Sept. 19. Part of an increasingly popular "agritainment" trend, it will be joined this year by nearly 140 affiliated MAiZE sites across the United States, Canada and Europe.

Rock City, in partnership with maze designer Brett Herbst ~ the world's leading designer of 330+ corn mazes-hopes to give even more people a chance to experience the unique source of good farmin' fun in their newly-designed labyrinth. Though the correct pathways can be walked in under 30 minutes, most directionally-challenged visitors - adults and children alike - will require about one hour to travel through more than two miles of twists and turns and 85 decision points.

Rock City's Enchanted MAiZE is a winner of the Southeast Tourism Society's Shining Example Award. The maze will give visitors the chance to "get lost" Sept. 19 through Nov. 1 It will be open to the public Thursdays 9 a.m.-8 p.m., Fridays-Saturdays 9 a.m.-10 p.m. and Sundays noon-8 p.m.. Special fieldtrip hours are available by reservation.

The Enchanted Maze is located at the foot of Lookout Mountain 2.5 miles from the Incline Railway Lower Station, just over the Georgia line. The cost is \$8.50 adult and \$6.50 child (4-12), and free for ages 3 & under. Also on site: the Pepsi Playground, historic Rock City barn, and tractor pulled hayrides. Special events are planned each weekend including Kidz Dayz every Saturday and Sunday noon till 6pm and the Forest of Fear, Friday and Saturday nights in October.
